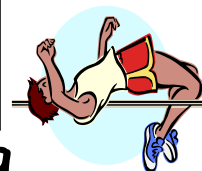

CODE OF CONDUCT

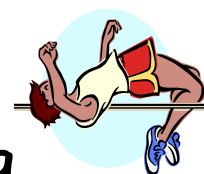
The public expects the highest standards from Banbury Harriers AC, no matter how they come into contact with us. As a member of Banbury Harriers you will be expected to maintain those standards when in contact with the public. You must maintain a polite and courteous manner at all times.

To help us achieve this we have a Code of Conduct for ALL members. If under 16, it is important that your parents(s) / guardian(s) also understand this Code of Conduct before you join.

1. During activities and whilst wearing Banbury Harriers colours, all athletes must treat all members of the public with respect and consideration (this includes not making inappropriate references to race, gender, religion etc)
2. All athletes will follow the guidance and instruction given to them by coaches and team managers.
3. There will be no smoking whilst at Banbury Harriers or during any club activity.
4. Inappropriate language or swearing will not be tolerated whilst at Banbury Harriers training sessions or events.
5. Bullying or offensive behaviour towards a fellow athlete or coach will not be tolerated. This includes 'play-fighting' or other inappropriate physical contact.
6. Athletes and coaches will show the proper respect due to fellow athletes and coaches.

Failure to comply with the above Code of Conduct may result in suspension from club activities. Serious or repetitive misconduct may result in expulsion from the club.
