Athletes sweat it out in memory of old Don

17/7/86

BANBURY Harriers held the fourth ten-mile road race on Sunday in memory of Don Sullivan who, as a life-long member of the club, could still be seen running the streets of the town at the age of 80!

In hot, sticky conditions, around 125 athletes began the tough course at Kings Sutton playing fields.

As the leaders went through Charlton, the field was beginning to string out behind them. From Hinton-in-the-Hedges until the final mile, a battle developed for the lead between

local runner Paul Varney and eventual winner John Exley. John's time of 54.51 was just two-and-a-half minutes outside the course record — a splendid effort in those conditions.

Paul Varney was second in 55.10 which was faster than his time last year.

Paul is having an excellent season so far this year with his victory at Fringford last week and a creditable 6th in the Banbury '5' the week before.

Third man home was Tim Hughes from White Horse Harriers in 55.19. The team prize was won by Oxford City with John Exley (1st), Michael Holder (4th) and Cliff Presit (6th).

First Banbury Harrier home was Dave Shadbolt in 11th place with a time of 56.49, also an improvement on last year.

One place behind him was the familiar face of ex-Banbury man Geoff Doily who came all the way from Swindon to support his old club.

The first veteran prize went to Pete Dixey of Witney Road Runners who was 14th overall and his time was 57.29.

Banbury Harrier Alec Leslie was second vet. home in a time of 59.01. Alec's 22nd place overall continues a good season for him.

Close behind Alec was third veteran, T. McLenanagan of White Horse Harriers in 23rd

place and 59.30.

The first lady to cross the line was Gloucester runner Dee Tsakarianos. She was 62nd overall and a veteran as well. Dee's time was 67.40.

Second lady was our own Kim Shaw (73rd in 68.57). Kim also became Oxon champion with this excellent performance.

Ann Howkins of Oxford City was third lady in a time of 71.28 and 83rd place overall.

The lady veteran winners prize also went to Gloucester AC when Liz Haines crossed the line in 97th place and 76 minutes 14 seconds after the start.

It is no surprise that several athletes dropped out of the race as it is a tough course and the weather was not ideal.

However 116 runners completed the course in just over one-and-a-half hours.

Special mention must be made of the youngest competitor, junior David Ward who drove himself extremely hard to finish 38th overall in an excellent time of 62.50.
