Runners' record hopes reach saturation point

SUNDAY'S terrible weather took its toll on the runners in the eighth AP20 road race from Leamington to Banbury.

Many of the top runners in the race found that the driving wind and rain was too much and their finishing times slower than expected.

The winner, Paul Kirrhead, of Woodstock Harriers, came home in a time of 1hr 55m 3s, nearly two minutes ahead of second placed man, Gene Woodwell, of Leamington AC, whose time was 1:57:41.

Third was Woodstock's Robin Gardner, 1:57:53, and Woodstock won the team prize when Andrew Batty finished 18th.

The second team was Oxford City AC, with Dave Parsons, 11th, Michael Holzer, 12th, and Peter Brackett, 16th.

Meanwhile, the first Banbury Harrier across the line was Dave Shadbolt, who was 10th in 2:02:39 which was two minutes faster than his previous time for the race.

were over 40, and many were non-runners, in the top of the field at the finish. First vet was G. Fildes, of Masses, Ferguson, in 1:58:54, who came in fifth.

Seventh vet was Jeff Corbitt in 14th place in 2:03:45 and third vet was Banbury Harriers' Clive McLeod in 20th place, in 2:05:45.

Just in the vet 0-39 section in 30th place overall was Ft. Deary, of OWLS AC in 2:11:46. Special mention should be made of Norman Paul, of Hermes AC, who completed the tough course in 2:28:47 to finish 108th.

Norman, a tough 64-year-old, has travelled from Brighton for the past few years to take part in the race.

This year, his daughter, Rosalind Cox, improved on her time last year by three minutes to finish 25 places above her dad in 8th place. Her time of 2:23:55 gave her the second ladies' place behind Sue Walters of Oxford City AC.

This is the second year that Sue has taken the ladies' title, finishing in 2:18:50 in comp in 59th, while Banbury Harriers' Kyr Shaw was third lady in 60th place in 2:28:34.

The AP 20 incorporates the Oxfordshire Championships for 20 miles, and this year's honours

go to Michael Hader and Sue Walters, both of Oxford City AC.

Rob Giron-Smith, nursing a rest muscle injury, started cautiously, running through five miles in 34:04, but increased pace through Bishop's Cleeve and Kenilworth to pass the ten-mile point in 04:20.

Unfortunately he was forced to pull out of the race at the 11th mile which was recorded in a time of 13:15.

Another local runner who successfully completed his first AP 20 race was Alan Wexhe who clocked a pleasing 2:47:22 in a round of applause from 500 supporters. Team prizes went to first placed Woodstock Harriers and Oxford City AC were second.
